Requirements for PhD Certificate:

1. **One required course: AAAS 699S (Pro seminar)**
2. **Three additional graduate-level courses** (500-level or above), two of which must be taught by AAAS core or secondary faculty. The third course may originate in another department, but must be approved by the DGS.
3. **Select either Option A, B or C:**
Option A: A teaching assistantship or instructorship in an AAAS-related undergraduate course. Assistantships must be supervised by an AAAS core or secondary faculty member. Instructorships must be sponsored by an AAAS core or secondary faculty member.
Option B: A fourth graduate course, excluding the Pro seminar, approved by the DGS.
Option C: The submission of a course proposal with syllabus for an AAAS graduate course. These options must be approved by the DGS.
4. **Dissertation:** A dissertation in an AAAS area with core or secondary faculty represented on the dissertation committee.
