## **Requirements for PhD Certificate students:**

- 1. One required course: AAAS 699S (Pro seminar)
- **2.** Three additional graduate-level courses (500-level or above), two of which must be taught by AAAS core or secondary faculty. The third course may originate in another department, but must be approved by the DGS.
- 3. Select either Option A, B or C:

**Option A:** A teaching assistantship or instructorship in an AAAS-related undergraduate course. Assistantships must be supervised by an AAAS core or secondary faculty member.

Instructorships must be sponsored by an AAAS core or secondary faculty member.

**Option B:** A fourth graduate course, excluding the Pro seminar, approved by the DGS.

**Option C:** The submission of a course proposal with syllabus for an AAAS graduate course.

These options must be approved by the DGS.

**4. Dissertation:** A dissertation in an AAAS area with core or secondary faculty represented on the dissertation committee.
